## PASTOR'S MESSAGE Finding Faith in Troubled Times

In most years, February is the month that serves as the beginning of Lent, and each year my February pastor's article would feature thoughts on Lenten preparation. But this year Lent waits until March to come a calling, which means that I will need to guide my pen to write on a different February topic

..... like the faith of Abraham Lincoln.

This past summer I found great enjoyment in reading the Lincoln biography "Team of Rivals" by Doris Kearns Goodwin. In the book, Goodwin shares the political genius of Abraham Lincoln as seen through the lens of his relationships with three men he selected for his cabinet, William H. Seward, Salmon P. Chase, and Edward Bates. All three of the cabinet members had been political rivals of Lincoln as all three ran against him for the 1860 Republican

presidential nomination. But after having lost the nomination to Lincoln, it was the wisdom of the 16<sup>th</sup> president to invite them to work with him as his cabinet during the difficult years of the Civil War. By the end of the biography, Doris Kearns Goodwin showed how all three of the men came to respect the many qualities of the great president, qualities that they had originally disdained.

Also woven into the biography was a snapshot of Lincoln's spiritual side, as Doris Kearns Goodwin offered up a picture of a man, a backwoodsmen who became president, who because of life situations eventual found faith. It was near the end of his life, that Lincoln told a few members of his cabinet:

> "When I left Springfield, I asked the people to pray for me; I was not a Christian. When I buried my son, the severest trial of my life, I was not a Christian. But when I saw the graves of thousands of our soldiers, I then and there consecrated myself to Christ. I do love Jesus."

**S**ometimes it is in life's difficulties that our vision becomes clearer, and it is then that we are lead to the foot of the Cross. It is in life's troubled waters that we call out for Jesus – who we then discover has been riding in the boat with us throughout our life, waiting for our call.




